

Checklist for the Million Dollar Project

- Decide on a theme
- Make a detailed list of the major categories you will need to spend money on. Do this on draft paper.
- Have a buddy double check your category list to make sure that you didn't leave anything out.
- List your final major category list on page 198 in your packet.
- List the category, items, and quantity needed on page 199. You will need an itemized accounting sheet for each major category that you have listed on page 198.
- Do specific price research for each of the items listed
- Complete the itemized sheet on page 199, adding the prices and calculating the amount you have spent on each item.
- Complete the major category sheet, adding the total amounts spent in each category. (pg. 199)
- Complete the calculations on page 200, finding the fraction, decimal, and percent of what you have spent.
- Complete the pie graph with percents, labels, and a title.
- Write a brief summary of how you spent the money in your project.
- Add a cover to your project and staple or place the projects pages behind the cover.
- Create a visual to share your project with the class. This could be a poster, power point presentation, etc.
