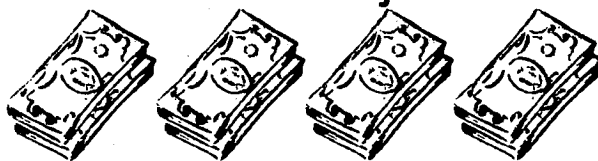


Million Dollar Project Rubric

TIPS:

- Written portion of project should be a least two paragraphs. The first paragraph should give a brief overview of how you spent your million dollars. The second paragraph should be about what you learned from this project.
- The oral presentation should be between one to two minutes. You will use your poster as a visual aid like during the Journey project. Be prepared to share how you spent your million dollars and what you learned from this project. You do not need to tell the prices of everything you bought. You may want to mention prices of very large purchases, otherwise just give an overview of your major categories. Tell a story and have fun with your presentation!
